

The Sheffield City Council Special Session was called to order by Mayor Nick Wilson at 6:00PM at the Sheffield City Hall on January 23rd, 2017. Council members in attendance were Jim Hegarty, JC McCaslin, Mike McKee, and Brad Mulford. Absent was Ron Simmons. Also in attendance were: Pat Nuehring, Public Works Director; Jessica Foreshoe, Library Director; and Police Deputy, Colten Kensett.

Mayor Wilson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Hegarty made a motion to approve the agenda as posted. Mulford seconded and it passed unanimously.

Mayor Wilson declared that it was time for anyone from the public to speak. None was heard.

New Business:

- Hegarty made a motion to approve the purchase of a new light by the Police Department using funds from the Police Seizure Fund. McCaslin seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
- Mulford made a motion to approve a resolution establishing a clothing allowance for employees. McCaslin seconded the motion and roll call vote was as follows, Ayes: Hegarty, McCaslin, McKee, Mulford; Ayes: None; Absent: Simmons. Mayor Wilson declared the resolution approved, adopted, and numbered 17-31. Discussion of credit cards for all full-time employees based on Resolution 17-1 occurred. Cards will be obtained for those who do not currently have them.
- Discussion regarding the FY2018 occurred.
- McCaslin made a motion to approve a resolution approving a raise for Public Works Director, Pat Nuehring, based on his anniversary date with the City. Mulford seconded the motion and roll call vote was as follows, Ayes: Hegarty, McCaslin, McKee, Mulford; Nays: None; Absent: Simmons. Mayor Wilson declared the resolution approved, adopted, and numbered 17-32.

Mayor/Council Remarks – Mayor Wilson reported that there have been some complaints of snow not being cleared from sidewalks. The consensus was to enforce the ordinance.

Hegarty motioned to adjourn the meeting, Mulford seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. Adjournment at 7:20PM.
