

The Sheffield City Council Special Session was called to order at Sheffield City Hall by Mayor Scott Sanders, at 6:00PM on Monday January 15th, 2018. Mayor/Council Comments – Nuehring told the council that something needed to be done with the lights in city park where the Veterans Memorial is concerned. He is working with Kevin Craighton on it.

Smit motioned to adjourn the meeting, Wilson seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. Adjournment at 9:37PM.
