

The Sheffield City Council Regular Session was called to order at Sheffield City Hall by Mayor Pro-Tem Dave Smit, at 7:07PM on Thursday, February 21st, 2019. Council Members in attendance were Jill Peterson, Dave Smit, and James Robbins. Brad Mulford & Nick Wilson were absent. Also, in attendance was Pat Nuehring, Public Works Director. Mayor Scott Sanders joined the meeting at 7:56PM.

Mayor Pro-Tem Smit led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Robbins made a motion to approve the agenda, Smit seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The City Clerk is asked to contact all four applicants to schedule phone interviews as well as request completed applications.
