

Monday, June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017 – 6:00PM

The Sheffield City Council Special Session was called to order at Sheffield City Hall by Mayor Pro Tem, Jim Hegarty, at 6:00PM on Monday June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Council Members in attendance were Jim Hegarty, Mike McKee, and Brad Mulford. Absent was JC McCaslin & James Robbins.

Mayor Pro Tem Hegarty led the Pledge of Allegiance.

McKee motioned to approve the agenda, Mulford seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

Mayor Pro Tem Hegarty announced that it was the time and place for the public forum. There was none.

McKee motioned to open the Public Hearing for Consideration of the FY2017 Budget Amendment 3, Hegarty seconded and it passed unanimously. No one was present from the public, so Hegarty motioned to close the public hearing, McKee seconded, and it passed unanimously.

In New Business:

- Mulford made a motion to approve a resolution approving the FY2017 Budget Amendment 3 and Hegarty seconded the motion. Roll call vote was as follows, Ayes: Hegarty, McKee, Mulford and Absent was McCaslin & Robbins. Mayor Pro Tem Hegarty declared the resolution approved, adopted, and numbered 17-56.
- McKee motioned to approve the fireworks permits for O'Connor, Wood, Fink, and Francis. Mulford seconded the motion and it approved unanimously.

McKee motioned to adjourn the meeting, Mulford seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. Adjournment at 6:08PM.
