

Monday, July 18th, 2016, 7:00PM

The Sheffield City Council Special Session was called to order at Sheffield City Hall by Mayor Nick Wilson at 7:05PM on Monday July 18th 2016. Council Members in attendance were Jim Hegarty, Mike McKee, & Brad Mulford. Also in attendance were Pat Nuehring, Public Works Director and Police Chief, Sam Cain.

Mayor Wilson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

McKee made a motion to approve the agenda. Hegarty seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Wilson announced that it was the time and place for the public forum. There was none.

In New Business:

- There was discussion regarding which option for to approve for the Brickyard Road paving project. Option 1 was to do ½ the road and some other patch projects around town for \$25,500. Option 2 was to do the whole road and the patch projects for \$42,000. After some discussion between the council and with Jeff Moellers from Heartland Asphalt, it was decided to do option #2. The project will be paid for out of road use tax reserve money. A resolution hiring Heartland Asphalt to complete the project was presented and Hegarty motioned to approve the resolution. Mulford seconded the motion and roll call vote was as follows, Ayes: Hegarty, McKee, Mulford. Mayor Wilson declared the resolution approved, adopted, and numbered 17-10.

Mayor/Council Comments – The city attorney recommended to use the employee handbook for the Chief of Police position instead of the contract proposed by Chief, Sam Cain. The bill for kenneling animals was brought up. There will be information gathered as to which kenneling business is the cheapest. The construction site at the new Wellness Center was discussed due to the dirt pile and the pond on the property. Small children have been playing there since the fence has been removed. The parking area south of West Fork School was mentioned. This is the old weight room site. Pat was asked about the cones at the alley entrance on South 4th Street. He said due to a water valve being there and the new rock needs to settle and harden before any driving should be done on that spot.

Hegarty motioned to adjourn the meeting, Mulford seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. Adjournment at 7:50PM.
