The Sheffield City Council Special Session was called to order at Sheffield City Hall by Mayor, Nick Wilson, at 7:05PM on Wednesday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2017. Council Members in attendance were Jim Hegarty, JC McCaslin, Mike McKee, Brad Mulford, and James Robbins. Also in attendance were Sam Cain, Police Chief and Colten Kensett, Police Deputy.

Mayor Wilson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Robbins motioned to approve the agenda, McCaslin seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

Mayor Wilson announced that it was the time and place for the public forum. There was none.

In New Business:

- Police Deputy Kensett requested a closed session with Chief Cain attending. Cain agreed. McKee motioned to enter a closed session, Mulford seconded and motion carried unanimously. They entered closed session at 7:07PM. McCaslin motioned to exit the closed session, Robbins seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously. They exited closed session at 8:34PM.
